



Fly Tying Seminar with Jack Dennis and Phil Rowley

I have developed a method to teach my fly patterns to intermediate and advanced tiers. Tiers will tie along with me and learn to tie new innovative flies and tying methods. I use a video camera projection system to project an image on a screen, wall or big screen TV. My guests tie along with me step by step as they view the screen behind me imagine a 10 ft caddis a tying image in all the detail. After I tie a step, I wait while everyone ties the step before moving on. We will tie some of my newest innovative patterns. They see each step on the screen and duplicate it with their own tools tying along with me with my live instruction. They can ask questions and receive advice on each step. **TYERS should have a basic knowledge of FLY TYING**

Each student is expected to provide the following items:

- Vise (pedestal or clamp – rotary or fixed)
- Bobbin prefer a Griffin ceramic Bobbin
- 4/Spools of thread – Tan, Brown or olive 6/0 or equivalent, and brown or olive 3/0 monocord or 140 Wapsi UTC , and 8/0 Gudebrod thread same colors as above (Jack will have samples of these threads to try if you do not bring them .)
- Pair of scissors
- Standard size hair stacker
- Rotary Hackle pliers
- Whip Finisher
- Jack can provide loaner tools if you do not have the above item
- **Jack Dennis will supply all the needed materials including hooks.** In addition, he will provide DVD for each student with tying instructions on all the patterns covered in the class along with a free personally tied fly.

The following patterns will be tied during the class

- Adams Para-Wulff
- Bullet Head Kiwi Muddler
- JD extended body Para-Wulff
- Euro Bead Head Caddis Nymph
- Micro Baetis Parachute emerger (2 versions)
- Grizzly Dragon
- Clearwater Pupa
- Herl May
- Fly Craft Fullback
- Balanced Leech
